
Quick-Start Guide





Mix 2.6 oz. of 2-Cycle Oil with 1 gallon of gasoline for a 50:1 mixture. Shake well, Pour into fuel tank.



Add bar oil to oil tank.



Turn switch to ON position and pull choke out fully (-).



Place foot in rear handle as shown. Pull starter rope sharply until engine attempts to start (approximately 5 pulls).



Push choke to half choke after engine attempts to start ([\]).





Pull starter rope as shown until engine starts.



Allow engine to warm for 30 seconds. Squeeze throttle trigger to set normal idle.



Disengage chain brake by pulling the hand guard back. The saw is now ready for use.



Turn switch to STOP position when finished using saw.

ATTENTION: NEVER

let your saw chain come in contact with soil/dirt during operation.

Letting your saw chain come in contact with soil/dirt while the chain is turning will completely dull your chain in a matter of seconds. This will result in poor cutting and will require purchasing a new chain.
